

Receive Jesus Christ with the Baptism of the Holy Spirit

To receive Jesus Christ with the baptism of the Holy Spirit, do/say the following with an open heart.

We always start with repentance, this simply means to turn away, think again with the desire to truly change direction from your current life.

Say the following prayer.

Father God I come to you as a sinner, I know that I have knowingly and unknowingly sinned against you. You created all things and you have created me, you are a Holy and Righteous God.

Now take a few minutes and think about the most important sins that come to mind. As an example they may be: anger, hatred, fornication, lying, stealing, adultery, hatred towards God, fear, depression etc.

Confess those out loud to God with a sorrowful heart. (Godly sorrow leads to repentance) Next take a deep breath and say.

I believe you sent your one and only Son Jesus Christ to die for my sins, who was crucified, died and buried and rose again on the third day.

Thank you Jesus for dying for me!

Wait a few moments, relax and even smile and say the following.

Jesus baptise me with your Holy Spirit, the promise of the Father,
I receive you, come Holy Spirit..... Come in power! Save me...set
me free... heal me.

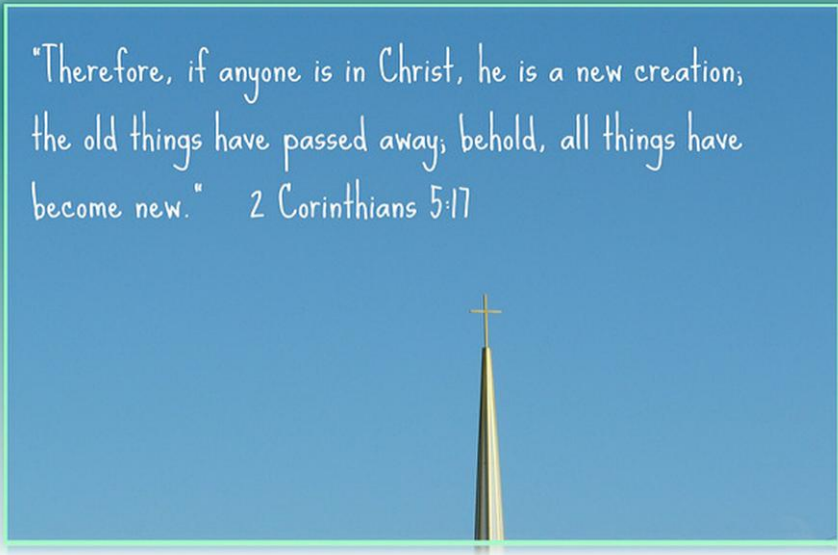
Wait... and just breath normally and by grace through Faith, you will receive the
baptism of the Holy Spirit. He may come and do some work in you, but don't
worry, He is very gentle.

Acts 1:8 says

8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you
will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the
ends of the earth.”
